

## Final Assignment: Video

The video should be educational, but fun. This is an opportunity for you to show off what you've learned about the local culture and the work culture that you have spent time in. We want to see you try to sum up your internship experience in 3-5 minutes, no easy task! The video can be any format, such as a 'day-in-the-life,' you talking into a camera, pictures of your experience with your voice over the top, or really anything you want to do. Be Creative!

The video should answer the following questions, but is not limited to only these questions:

- What is your name, what school do you go to in the US?
- What city did you intern in? What was the name of the company?
- Describe your greatest success in the internship. Why was it such a big success for you?
- What was your biggest challenge in the internship? Why was it such a challenge for you?
- What skills did you learn that you think will help you most in your career?
- What advice would you give to future interns?

The Video is worth 10 points. The video will be graded mostly on thorough answers to the above questions, using examples in your answers, and expressing your points clearly. Video and production quality will be looked at, but not make of the majority of the grade.
